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DRUG UTILIZATION REVIEW: Opioid Dosing Guidelines (120 MED/day)

- Data showing results of original Narcotic Review Program
- Data showing deaths while on Opioids in Washington Medicaid

1. Background: Washington Medicaid has successfully operated a Narcotic Review program which was originally based on Medicaid clients receiving high numbers of narcotic prescriptions.
2. Today's Presentation: David Mancuso and Scott Best will present data showing latest statistics in the Narcotic Review Program (NRP). Drs. Thompson and Franklin will talk about next steps to further the use of the Opioid Dosing Guidelines:
 - >120 Morphine Equivalent Dose (MED)/day as a new trigger for the NRP
 - Pain contracts for those patients receiving >120 MEQ/day
3. Expected Outcome: DUR Board approval of next steps
